#### Live Oak, California (2021)

- New Continuous sidewalks
- Created a pedestrian-focused environment by
- Enhanced parking and building access
- Improved crosswalks, curbs, gutters, sidewalks and driveways
- American with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards




#### Modesto, California (2015)

- Two-way cycle track which is separated by concrete curbs
- Buffered cycle track connectivity to multiple locations
- Wayfinding and signage for pedestrians and bicyclists



#### Kings Beach, CA (2016)

- New Continuous sidewalks
- Improved crosswalks, curbs, gutters, sidewalks and driveways
- Created a pedestrian-focused downtown environment by enhancing parking, way-finding signage, landscaping, and facilities for bicyclists and pedestrians




#### Truckee, CA (2021)

- Improved crosswalks, curbs, gutters, sidewalks and driveways
- Enhancing parking

- Center median provides buffer for pedestrians to safely cross



#### Grants Pass, Oregon

- Center median landscaping
- Facilities for bicyclists and pedestrians




#### Vineyard Drive, California

- New Sidewalks












